Mix completely before using. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. If contact occurs, flush immediately with water. Always mix away from carpeted floors to avoid damage. Properly cover all desks, cabinets, furniture, flooring, etc. and be cautious or cover delicate fabric walls and curtains near heavily soiled ceilings. Always dust or vacuum heavily soiled, dusty and sooty areas before spraying, wear goggles or eye protection and face mask or respirator to avoid eye irritation and inhalation of mist.

EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE

Inhalation: Adverse health effects from vapors or spray mists in poorly ventilated areas may include irritation of the mucous membranes of the nose, throat and respiratory tract and symptoms of headache and nausea.

Skin Contact: Prolonged or repeated contact with product may cause skin irritation.

Eye Contact: Direct contact with product may result in eye irritation.

Inhalation: Remove subject to fresh air.

Eye and Skin Contact. Promptly and thoroughly wash eyes with water for at least 15 minutes and consult physician if irritation persists; wash skin thoroughly with soap and water; if drenched, remove and wash clothing before reuse.

Ingestion: If victim is conscious, give two glasses of water to drink. Call a physician. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
